DON BOSCO NAVAJEEVAN CARE HOMES

Inspired by the vision of Don Bosco, the founder of the Salesian Society, Don Bosco Navajeevan was started in 1998 in the twin cities of Hyderabad for the care. protection and rehabilitation of the Young at Risk (YaR). The four centres of Don Bosco Navajeevan serve as homes for the street, poor, orphan and marginalized boys and girls of the society who are picked up from vulnerable and conflicting situations. With the help of the street educators, field staff and the child welfare committee (CWC) of the Government they are rescued and rehabilitated after much counselling alongside providing for all their basic and essential needs.

Since the beginning, DBNJ contacted 32,799 children and among them 13,652 were registered at the centres to receive various services

As many as 7,460 children got home placed and about 3.622 were rehabilitated in **DBNJ** Homes.

At present, 60 girls and 120 boys are pursuing formal education and vocational training in DBNJ.

Major Activities From July to September 2023

College Admissions for Girls, Havathnagar: July 6, 2023: Don Bosco



Navajeevan commended P. Poojitha. S.Lavanya, P. Meghana, S. Keerthana, M. Chitti and N. Radha for their overwhelming success in 10th standard examinations. After their results, these girls were made aware through career guidance sessions of the innumerable opportunities of study/courses available as they step in to college life. A personal interaction with

every student contributed to choosing a career path that would settle them well in life. Recognizing their aspirations for further education, the girls were enrolled in Smt. Durgabai Deshmukh Women's Technical Training Institute for their Polytechnic studies. Sr. Shoba and her team made necessary arrangements with the assistance of CWC Rangareddy District as the girls were on the threshold of a new college environment.

Mother's Month" Inauguration and Competitions - Ramanthapur: July 16,

2023: The youngsters in Ramanthapur celebrated meaningfully 'Marian Month' with the theme "Mother's Month." This programme was inaugurated by Fr. Christu in the presence of Fr. Thomas Remalla, Fr. Gnanam, Fr. Arogya who encouraged the children to participate in the special events wholeheartedly. A month-long activity was aimed at recalling the ever-protective



role of the mother in each one's lives. A lot of time was spent on sharing the intimate moments of being in the lap of their mothers which further led them to express deepest gratitude for the selfless sacrifices their mothers made to raise them up. Drawing competitions and singing competitions were unique as the children creatively expressed their love for their mothers.

Staff Training Programme (Training of Trainers): July 17, 2023: The DBNJ management organized in Ramanthapur a day-long Google for Nonprofit input sessions with hands on experience for the in-charges, wardens and department heads of all four centres. The purpose of this training was to introduce computing tools to make certain clean operations regarding the preservation of

daily diaries, chronicles, newsletters and accounts. Mr. Ramesh and Fr. Arogya explained in detail various practices that would help in



documenting the impact being created in the mission for the young at risk as well as bringing more transparency into the system. Fr. Thomas Remalla, Director stressed on the importance of staying connected with one another as every DBNJ team member moves ahead to bring a positive change in the most marginalized children and youth.

Genpact visit at Ramanthapur: July 18, 2023: A group



of clients, senior management and team members from GENPACT visited Don Bosco Navajeevan Ramanthapur to spend time with the beneficiary

children. They visited the residence of children, skill training centre and study halls while interacting with the children about their goals and dreams. Later, they distributed provisions and educational stationery to all the children.
